Uploading Content

You can upload your Camtasia content to Screencast.com using a few different methods.

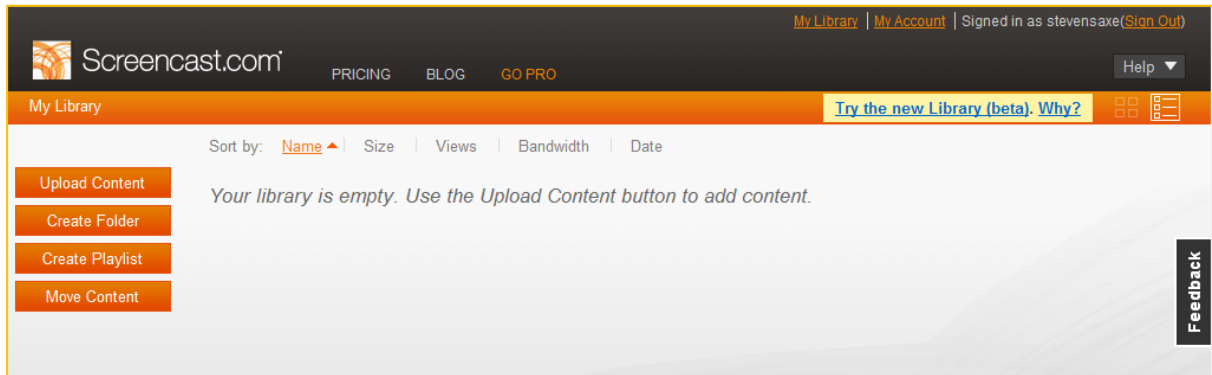
Follow the below steps to upload your content directly from Screencast.com.

Once you have a Screencast.com account, you will likely want to start uploading your Camtasia content to Screencast.com.

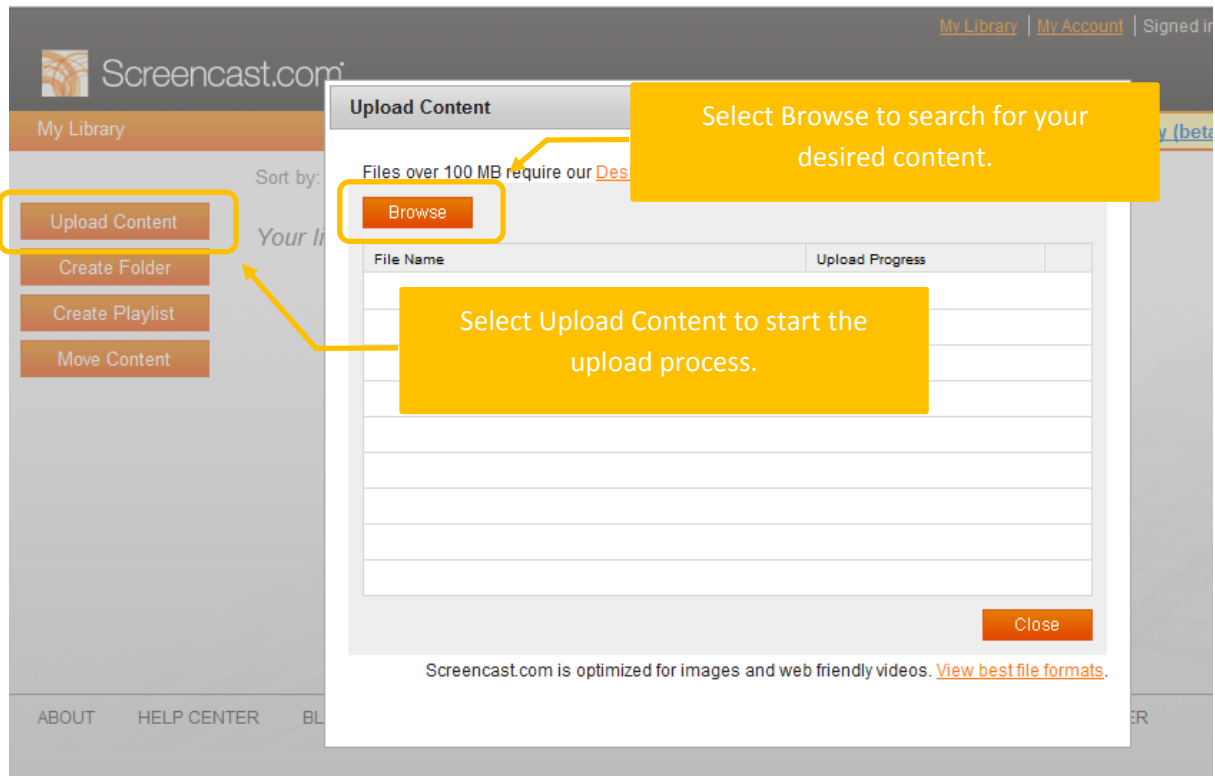
Although there are a few different ways to upload content, an easy way is directly from your Screencast.com account.

To upload content directly from your Screencast.com account, complete the following steps:


1. Go to <http://www.screencast.com/> and sign in to your account.



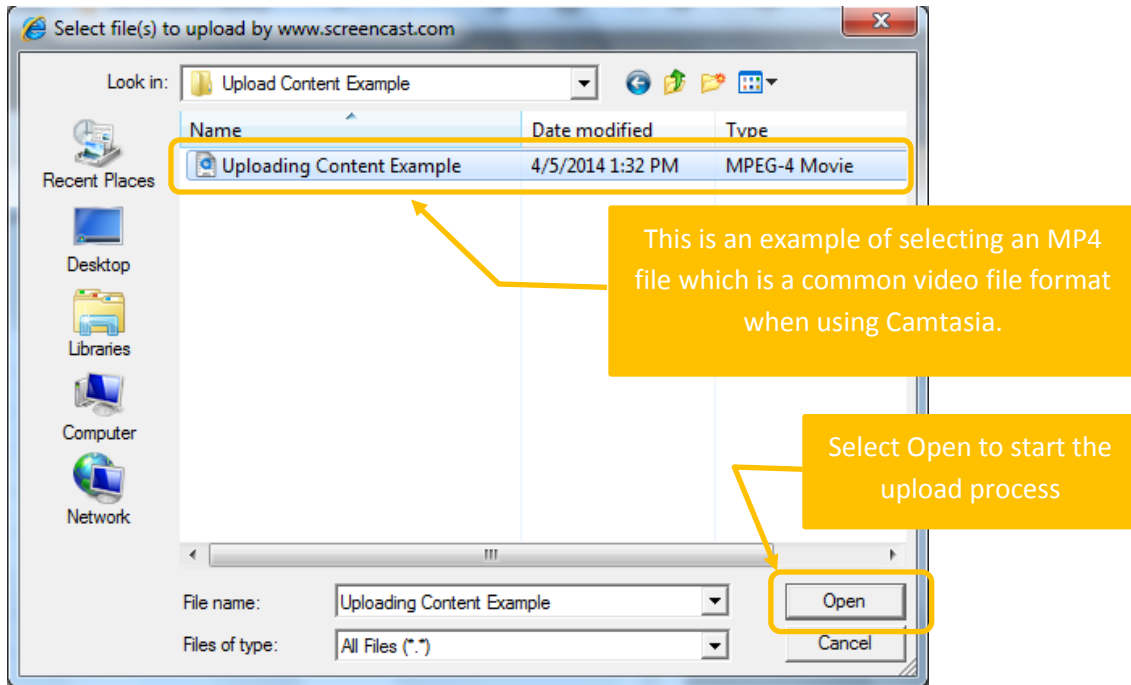
2. Select **Upload Content** button to display the **Upload Content** window:



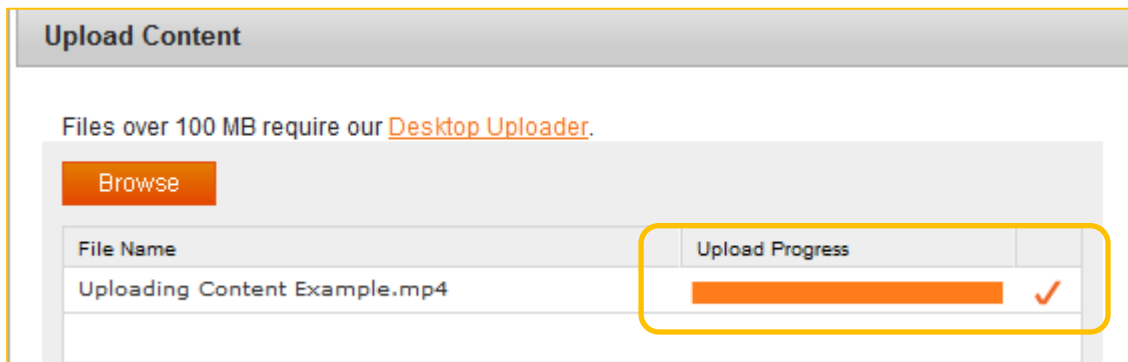
3. Select **Browse** button to search for the file (e.g., MP4, MP3, etc.) that you want to upload.

	<p>Note: You can upload several different files types to Screencast.com (see Screencast.com for additional information on all the available file formats).</p> <p><i>This tutorial describes adding an MP4 file as that is a common video file format produced when using Camtasia.</i></p>

4. Navigate to and select the desired file and select **Open**:




5. View the **Upload Progress status bar**.
 - a. Check mark will indicate the upload it complete:




6. Select **Close** button after your selected file has finished uploading.

7. Your selected content is now uploaded to your Screencast.com library:
